**EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST SOUGHT FOR MACKAY
CONTAINER REFUND POINTS**

Container Exchange (COEX) is seeking Expressions of Interest from individuals, community groups and businesses interested in operating a container refund point (CRP) in Mackay.

COEX is the not-for-profit that delivers the Containers for Change scheme in Queensland, which encourages Queenslanders to reduce litter and increase recycling across the state by returning their eligible beverage containers at a CRP for 10-cents per eligible container.

The successful CRP will be based in one of the following areas—Andergrove, Beaconsfield, Blacks Beach, Bucasia, Cremorne, Dolphin Heads, Eimeo, Glenella, Mount Pleasant, Nindaroo, North Mackay, Richmond, Rural View, Shoal Point or Slade Point—providing locals with easier access to the scheme.

COEX Chief Executive Officer Ken Noye recognises how important it is to provide Queenslanders with accessibility to the scheme.

“After just over one year of operation, we continue to work with local councils, businesses and communities on identifying opportunities to improve access to the scheme,” said Mr Noye.
