

July: Scheme collection volumes showing continued strong growth, with a 11% increase in total collections over the past 12 months

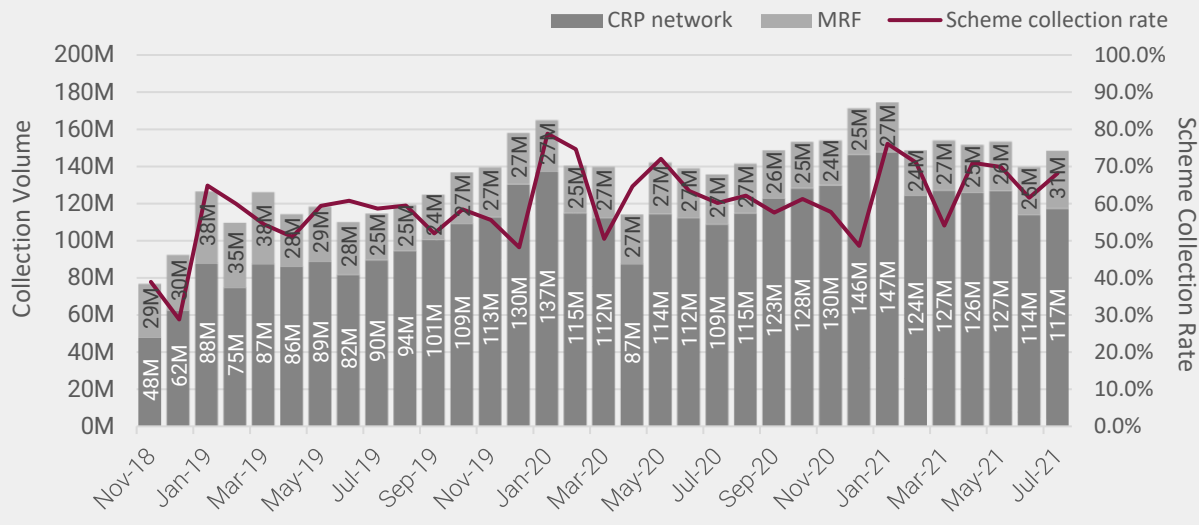
Container volumes



The *Containers for Change* scheme receives containers collected through the Container Refund Point (CRP) network and from those containers returned through council kerbside recycling which end up at Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs). Both avenues make up the overall scheme collection volumes and rate.

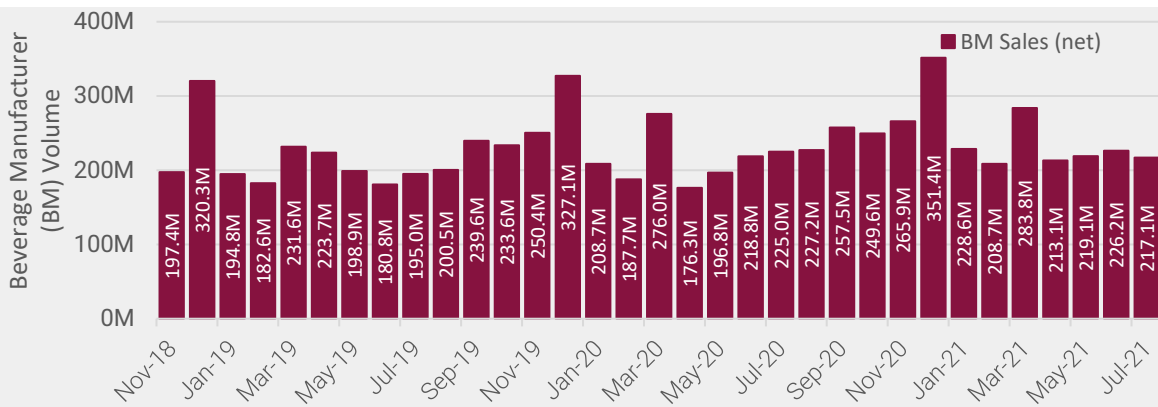
**Scheme collection volumes impacted by COVID-19 pandemic from March 2020.*

To note: July 2021 MRF volumes are forecast volumes, as MRF audits are quarterly in arrears.



Key insights:

- July 2021 delivered scheme collections of 148m containers, impacted by COVID-19 lockdown
- Scheme collection rate of 68% in July 2021 and average of 62% during the 2020/21 financial year
- Scheme collection volumes of 1.83b containers over the past 12 months, an increase of 183m containers (+11%)



Key insights:

- Approximately 2.95 billion containers have been sold and consumed in Queensland in the past 12 months (+8% YoY)
- BM Sales (net) in July 2021 of 217.1m were 4% lower than last year



Container Refund Points (CRPs)

313 sites (including 145 temporarily suspended sites due to COVID-19)

Containers for Change have 313 CRP sites, including 145 temporarily suspended sites due to COVID-19 lockdown impacts **as at 31 July 2021**. At the completion of the lockdown all 145 suspended sites returned to operation.
