

## Expression of Interest (EOI) – Logistics Service Providers

**Container Exchange (COEX) wishes to engage Logistics Service Providers to share in our vision of “No Container Goes to Waste” through transportation of collected beverage containers from Container Refund Points to processing facilities across Queensland.**

### Background

Container Exchange (COEX) is appointed by the Queensland government to manage and grow Queensland’s container refund scheme (the **Scheme**) – Containers for Change.

Our not-for-profit status drives us to invest where it matters to ensure all Queenslanders can access the benefits Containers for Change brings to individuals, charities, community groups and social enterprises across the state. We are proud to be tasked with delivering a state-based scheme that continues to deliver positive social, environmental and economic impacts across Queensland.

Approximately 3.8 billion beverage containers are sold in Queensland each year with around 95% of these consumed within the state. These containers are the second most littered item in the state. Since the launch of the scheme in November 2018, COEX has overseen the creation of significant and meaningful change for the people of Queensland, including the collection of over 8 billion containers through 350 Container Refund Points (**CRPs**). The number of containers collected and processed continues to increase year-on-year.

Once the containers are collected, counted, sorted and consolidated through the current 179 CRP depots, COEX oversees the movement of these materials through processing and the subsequent recycling for use in the circular economy. Part of this includes engaging Logistics Service Providers (**LSPs**) to transport collected beverage containers from CRP depots to processing facilities.

COEX is looking to work with businesses that share our values when delivering the Scheme.

### Opportunity

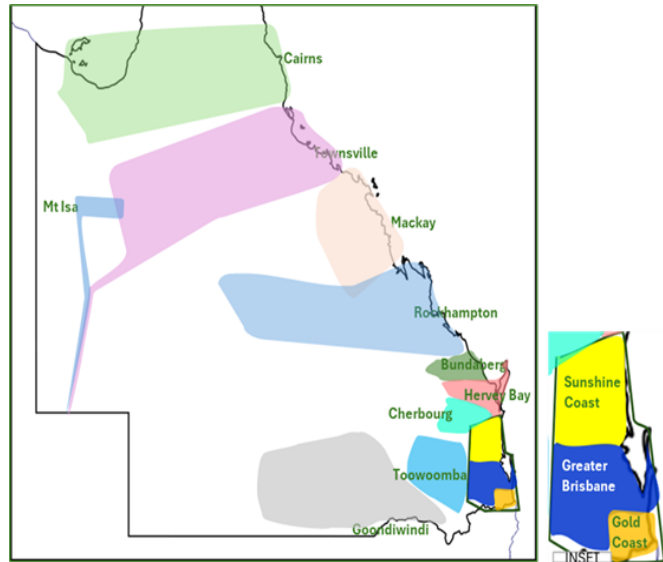
The majority of COEX’s existing Logistics Service Agreements (**LSAs**) are expiring in late 2025 and COEX is seeking Expressions of Interest (**EOIs**) from transport operators and LSPs (both existing and new) to operate across 14 container collection regions throughout Queensland.

This EOI is an information gathering process in which COEX is seeking to understand the supplier market and range of logistics solutions that may be available to transport the collection shipping units containing beverage containers across specified regions. This EOI is the first stage of a multi-stage procurement process. Only those respondents who submit a compliant response to the EOI will be invited to participate in the subsequent stages, with the next stage being a detailed Request for Proposal (**RFP**). The RFP will provide detailed information on the preferred operating region/s to align with the Respondents’ EOI response to capably provide specific logistics services. The RFP will also request detailed administration, operational and fleet background information from the Respondent which may be additional to the information provided in the EOI submission form.

**Regions:** (Map is not to scale and all shaded areas are indicative only)

The regions that are to be serviced under the new LSAs are:

- Greater Brisbane
- Gold Coast
- Sunshine Coast
- Toowoomba - Darling Downs/Granite Belt
- Goondiwindi – Southwest
- Wide Bay - Cherbourg
- Wide Bay - Hervey Bay / Maryborough
- Wide Bay - Bundaberg
- Cairns
- Townsville
- Mackay
- Fitzroy - Rockhampton/Gladstone
- Central Qld – Emerald / Highlands / & West
- Mt Isa

## Scope

LSPs must be willing and able to provide logistics services to transport eligible collected beverage containers in one or more of the regions specified above.

## Materials:

LSPs will be required to transport the following material types:

- Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET; clear and coloured)
- High Density Polyethylene (HDPE; clear and coloured)
- Aluminium
- Glass (all colours)
- Liquid Paperboard, and
- Steel

## Vehicle types:

Vehicle types may vary depending on the equipment and regional requirements, but previous considerations have included:

- Rigid and Semi flatbed
- Rigid and Semi tautliner
- Drop deck semi-tautliner
- Mezzanine deck semi- tautliner
- Hook lift / Roll-on Roll-off
- Truck and Trailer
- Rear-loader

## Equipment

LSPs are not required to provide their own collection infrastructure, but COEX is open to consideration of any other potential solutions.

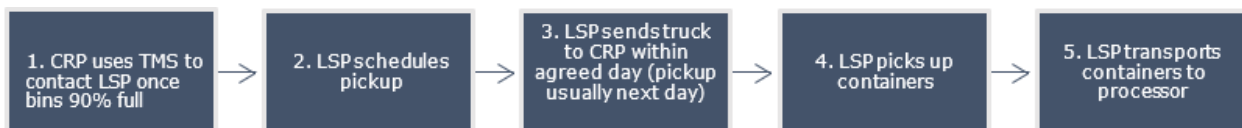
Equipment is provided to LSPs from COEX’s equipment pool and generally loaded onto logistics vehicles at contracted processing facilities and transported between the Processor and Container Collection Points. LSPs are responsible for conducting their own verification checks on the equipment.

Equipment will vary depending on a collection site’s requirements. As a LSP within the Scheme, you should expect to carry any number of the following examples of equipment within your fleet (please note the below list is not exhaustive):

- 30m3 Hook bins
- 20m3 Hook bins
- 15m3 Hook bins
- 2.8m3 mesh lined cages
- 1.4m3 steel mesh lined cages
- 1.4m3 sheet steel lined cages
- 1.1m3 plastic bins
- IBC’s and Bulka Bags
- Adoption of other technologies as they become available

## How will the change in and change out of equipment operate?

Logistics at COEX currently runs as a changeover system. A brief outline of the standard process is shown below and approximate distances between CRPs and processors in each region are included in Appendix 2. This will be defined in more detail to Respondents if successful in this EOI process.



## Who can submit an EOI?

COEX is interested in hearing from any transport operators and LSPs (existing or new) who are interested in providing a cost effective, or possibly an innovative or alternative, logistics solution that aligns with COEX's values and strategic objectives.

### **Assessment of EOIs – Minimum Qualifier Requirements**

The following section outlines some of the questions and considerations that COEX will use through the multi-stage procurement process. Some questions will go into more depth in relation to some Respondents and their business details. To register interest for the provision of logistics services, please complete the EOI Response Submission Document in Appendix 3.

LSPs are expected to have the following (at a minimum:)

- Capacity to service their nominated regions from approximately October 2025 (specific start date may vary across regions)
- Availability to operate 6 days per week
- Preparedness to use the COEX transport management system
- Relevant business insurances
- A current safety record and safety plan
- Operating in compliance with Heavy Vehicle National Law, including Chain of Responsibility and Load Restraint
- Compliance with all State employment laws and awards including anti-slavery laws and the ethical supplier threshold
- Possessing relevant industry accreditations under NHVAS and Truck Safe guideline compliance

### Assessment of RFPs:

The table below outlines criteria for assessing the responses in the RFP stage.

However, the Respondent acknowledges that this criteria is not final and may be subject to change prior to the release of the RFP.

The terms and conditions set out in this section are a condition of, and will apply to the Respondent's participation in the EOI process to become a LSP.

### Liability

To the extent permitted by law, COEX disclaims all liability (whether in contract, tort (including negligence), under statute or otherwise) arising from information contained in or omitted from this EOI or otherwise provided to any Respondent.

### No Warranties

COEX makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, as to the reliability or completeness of the information contained in this EOI, or any information that may be provided in association with it, including any information provided by COEX in response to any enquiry.

### Respondents to Inform Themselves

By submitting a response, Respondents are deemed to have:

- examined and considered this EOI, all other information made available to Respondents in writing by COEX in connection with this EOI and all other necessary information which may be relevant to the risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may have an effect on their response;
- satisfied themselves as to the correctness and sufficiency of their response; and
- acknowledged and agreed that they do not rely on any oral or written warranty or representation by or on behalf of COEX, including any warranty or representation.

### Reservation of Rights

COEX reserves the right to (in its absolute discretion):

- vary or amend the terms and conditions of the EOI at any time;
- terminate the process outlined in this EOI at any time;
- select Respondents or choose not to do so;
- reject Respondents; and
- award multiple contracts that may result in competition.

### Decision Making

COEX has absolute discretion in connection with any and all decisions made or actions taken, refused to be made or taken or required to be made or taken by it in connection with this EOI. To the extent permitted by law, COEX has no liability to any Respondent for any such decision, action or refusal.

### Confidential Information

Any information supplied by or on behalf of COEX to Respondents which is not in the public domain is the confidential information of COEX. Respondents must maintain confidentiality of that information. Respondents may disclose, with the prior written consent of COEX, the confidential information provided to it by COEX to a consultant it engages for the purpose of this EOI. Any such consultant must preserve the confidentiality of the confidential information disclosed to it. It is the responsibility of the Respondent to ensure that they do so.

If any part of a response is confidential information to the Respondent, it must be clearly marked as confidential. Respondents must only mark those parts of their response that are actually confidential. COEX will take reasonable steps to keep confidential those parts of a response that are clearly marked as confidential and that actually contain confidential information, but COEX may disclose:

- any part of a response where that disclosure is authorised or required by law; or
- confidential information (including response documentation) to its consultants, Respondents, the State or advisers for the purpose of assessing the response or awarding a contract.

Respondents grant documentation supplied by or used in its response for any purpose in connection with the assessment of the response or awarding a contract.

Any information or documentation supplied by or on behalf of COEX to Respondents in connection with this EOI remains the property of COEX.

At the request of COEX, Respondents must return or destroy any and all documentation supplied by or on behalf of COEX in connection with this EOI.

### Reliance by COEX

COEX may, without any further communication with a Respondent, rely on all conduct and representations of any kind (whether solicited or not) by a Respondent in connection with this EOI, including any representations made or information provided by a Respondent in response to any

clarification questions asked by COEX as part of its evaluation of Respondents.

### Legal Implications of this EOI

This EOI is not an offer capable of acceptance and therefore will not form part of a contract between COEX and a Respondent.

No contractual obligations, express or implied, will arise between COEX and a Respondent as a result of COEX's provision of this EOI or a Respondent's submission of a response.

To the extent permitted by law, Respondents will have no claim against COEX arising out of COEX's release of this EOI, nor any exercise or failure to exercise any of its rights under this EOI.

### Governing law

The laws of Queensland apply to this EOI. COEX and the Respondents irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland.
