



POS Installation Instructions

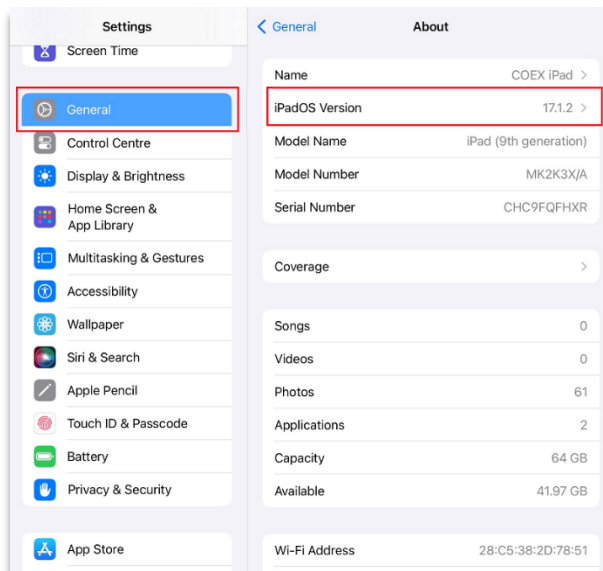
This guide will walk you through the necessary steps to install POS on your iPad and Windows platforms.

Note:

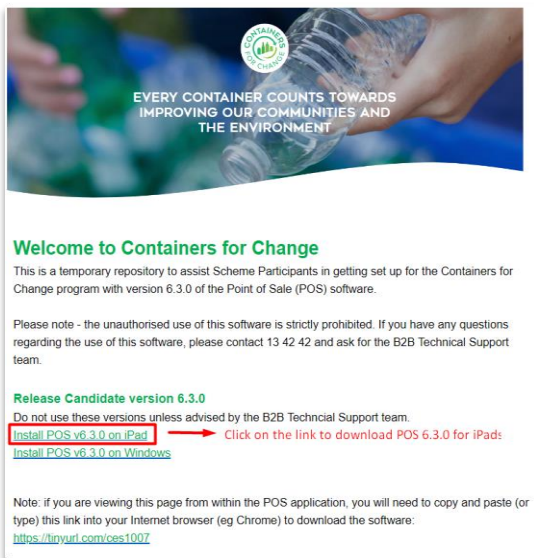
- In case you already have an old version of POS (v5.xx.x) installed on your system, you will have to uninstall the application and then do a fresh install of the most up to date version.
 - As you are installing a new application, you will need to restore your previous settings of the POS application.
- For all versions above v6.xx.x the new application will simply overwrite the existing application.

iPad

1. Ensure your iPad device operating system is iPadOS 17 or higher. This can be checked in your iPad settings -> General -> About

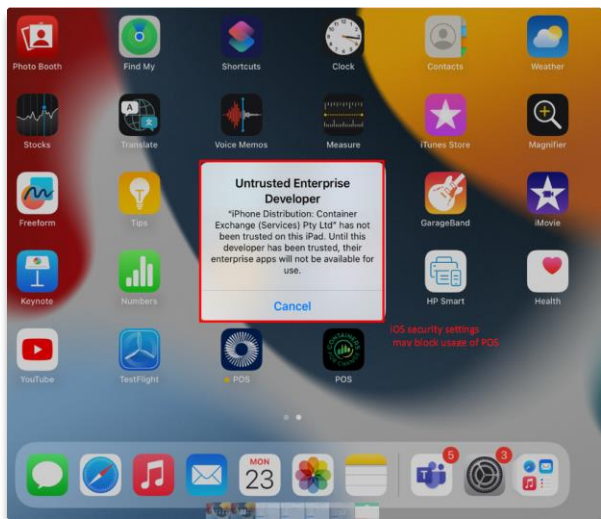


2. Download the application using the following link - [POS Download Link](#)

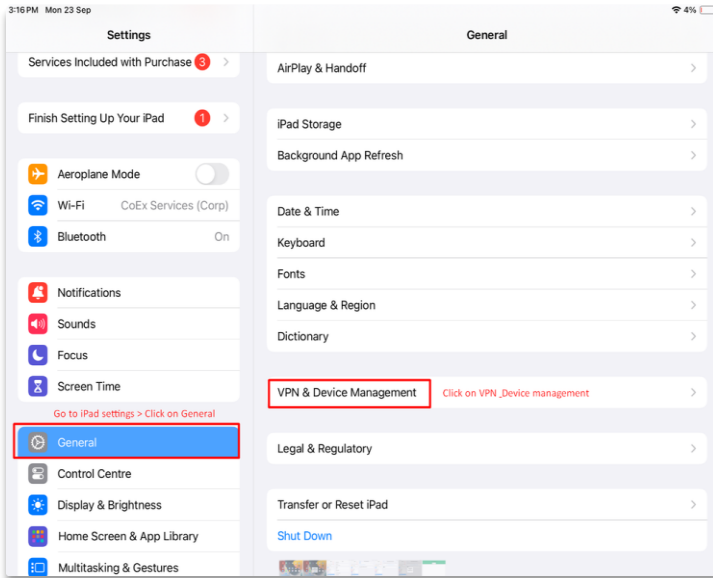


3. Download URL
4. Once downloaded the application will auto-install in the background.
5. Look for the POS application and run it.

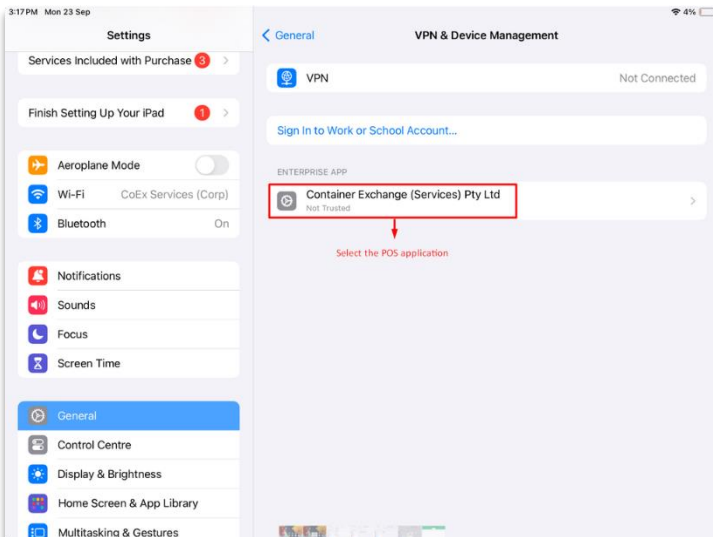
Untrusted Application Troubleshoot - iOS security may block usage of POS.



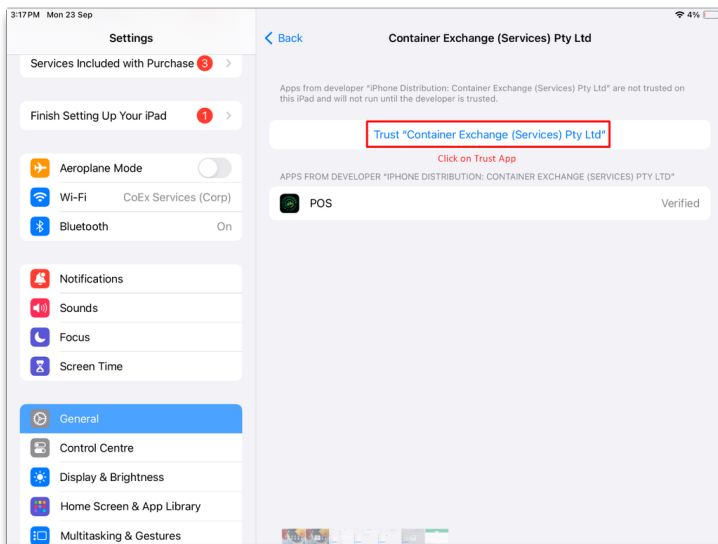
6. Go to iPad settings - General > VPN & Device Management



7. Select 'Container Exchange (Services) Pty Ltd



8. Select POS and Trust the application.



9. Select POS and Trust the application.
10. Re-run the POS Application and it should start.
11. Login using your CRPO Business Portal credentials.

Windows

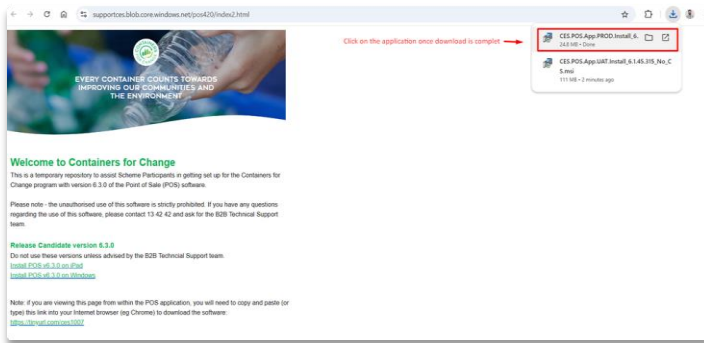
Note: The installation steps are for Windows 10 and higher.

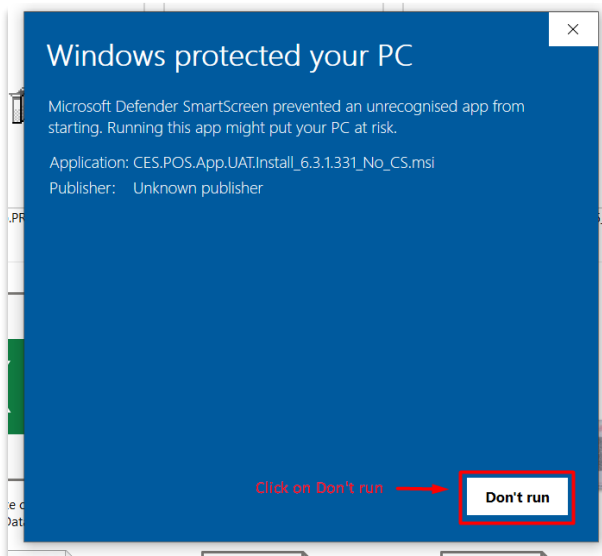

3. Run the downloaded application.

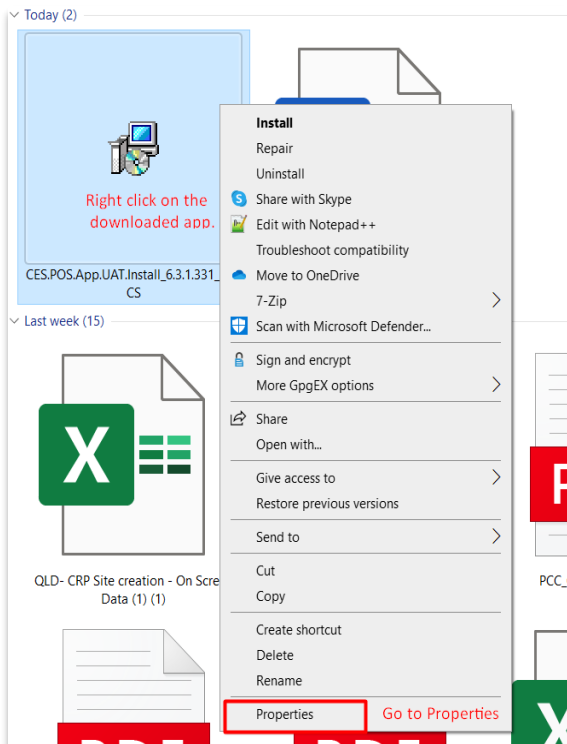


4. Some Windows machines may give a runtime error due to Security settings. Skip to step 8, if this issue does not apply to you.

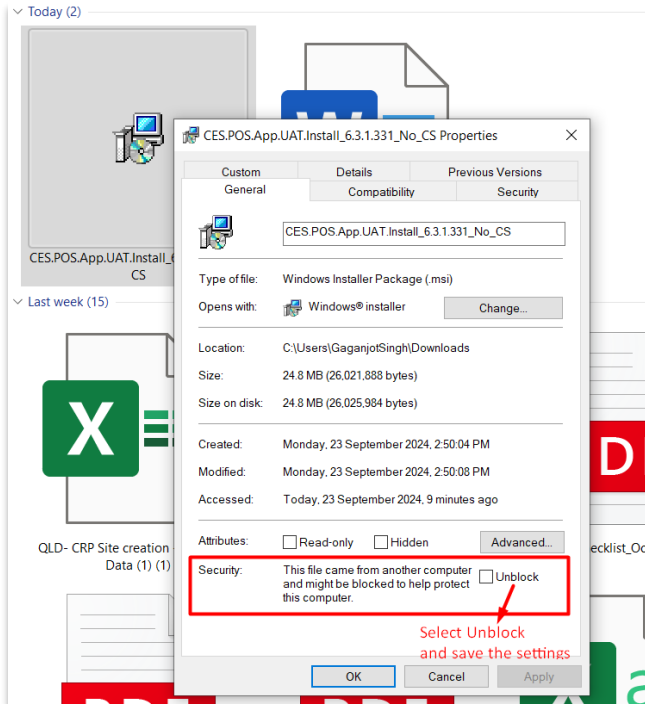


5. Don't run

6. Go to Properties - Right-click on the installer file and go to properties.

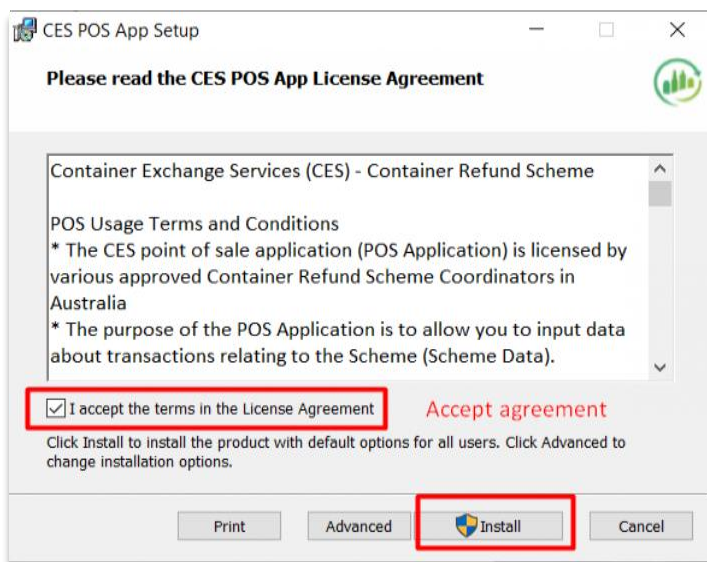


7. Unblock security settings and save / apply.

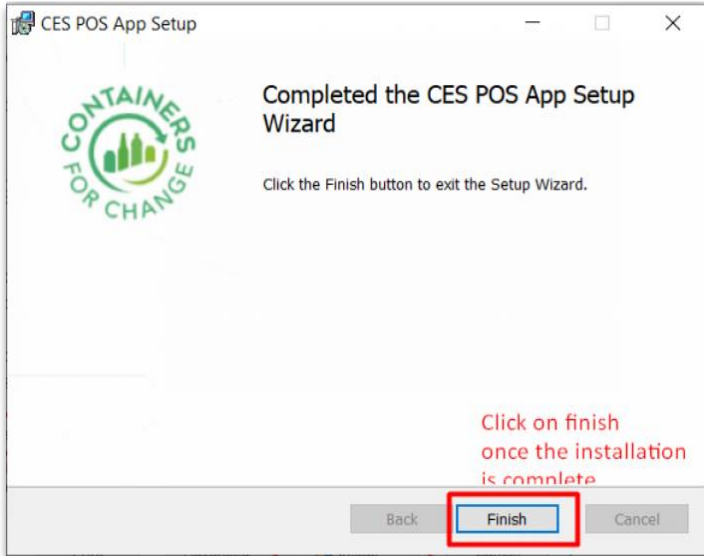


8. Run the installer application and the installation wizard should start.

9. Accept the terms and Install.
