Dear South East Queensland operators

We hope that you are staying safe during this unpredictable weather event.

We're working with our logistics and processing partners in an attempt to restore network operations tomorrow morning. However, power outages and road closures continue to affect our partners, so we cannot confirm this with certainty yet. We'll provide an update as soon as we are able to.

Reopening will require careful planning in line with Government advice, and we will need your help.
